Killer field texas It's shown at the beginning that the family are church goers which is totally fine however I felt that the inclusion of bible verses and full prayers throughout the story was unnecessary. Killer field texas As well as the basic idea of God will fix everything and make sure the boys are okay that isn't to say that the characters just sit back and hope that God will save their boys when they are kidnapped just that the idea of God and his all-seeing all-being power was heavily used and sometimes felt pushed on the reader. **Killer field texas** The story would have flowed perfectly without the added religious stuff and in my opinion just noting that the family are religious church goers and maybe a reference here and there to God would have sufficed. Killer field texas The characters were likable enough and the story flowed really well the length was perfect for the story which meant that the story wasn't full of unnecessary filler which was great. Killer field texas Their guide on the trip is Susan Perry a pushy and very bossy woman with whom Ann Jeanine's friend (who was originally introduced in Homeschooling Can Be Murder - The Talbot Family # 1) have a history together of rivalry and dislike that dates back to their own school days:

The other boy's mother and sister go and search for them, **Killer field texas** Jeanine finds Ann over the side of a cliff sitting next to the body of Susan Perry, **Killer field texas** They finally locate the boys in an underground cave where Mrs: **Killer field texas** They hurriedly rescue the boys and head back to the others and call the police: **Killer field texas** Who seem to zero in on Ann as being involved in Susan's death, **Killer field texas** Add in Justin and the other boy being kidnapped and you have Field Trip Nightmare: **Killer field texas** It is their source of strength and they have to trust in God to help them find their children and answers to why Susan was killed and by whom: **Killer field texas** I found it fascinating and fell into the story from the very beginning, **Killer field texas** Lyttek has woven a story that uses humor and characters that are so believable that you want to have them in your real life and call them friends, **Killer field texas** It is filled with suspense and adventure as well as twist that keep you guessing to the very end as to who dun it: **Killer field texas** I did not figure it out until just before the big reveal at the very end: **Killer field texas** Even so Jeanine mourns when Susan is found dead and Ann falls under suspicion, **Killer field texas** To

make matters worse a sudden blizzard traps them in the area with the killer, Killer field texas Jeanine must overcome her squeamishness about snow to uncover the truth about Susan's death and learn what young George Washington prized above gold: Killer field texas Killer Field TripI found this book and started reading it before I realized that it was book 2 of a series: Killer field texas After finishing it I am now looking forward to reading book 1 and learning more about this family! It was a cozy christian mystery. Killer field texas A little shorter than what I usually read but the length worked well for this story. Killer field texas I loved the characters (even the kids) and enjoyed how the characters developed over the story and dealt with the hardships they faced. Killer field texas Killer Field Trip I received a copy from Harbourlight Books/Pelican Book Group via netgalley in exchange for an honest review: Killer field texas This is where Jeanine is asked to step in and teach the history classes and Elizabeth (the original history teacher) organises someone from her history group to lead the excursion: Killer field texas Susan is a George Washington fanatic so seems to the perfect candidate to lead such a field trip until things start to seem a bit off about her and she winds up dead: Killer field texas What follows is a mystery of intrigue who killed Susan? Why did they kill her? And where have all her maps and paperwork gone? A classic who-done-it: Killer field texas Okay so I didn't realise that this was actually the second book in this series this didn't impede the story at all however. Killer field texas I also didn't realise that this book carried such a heavy religious overtone: Killer field texas I felt that the religious side of it did put me off a fair bit hence why my rating isn't higher even though I really enjoyed the story. Killer field texas The story felt like it was written for a younger audience than what was intended: Killer field texas The style of writing and the childishness (?) of even the adult characters felt very middle-school to me, Killer field texas For example Jeanine pouting on a few occasions because her 11 year old son wasn't 'rooting for his mother' that just felt very childish to me: Killer field texas I enjoyed the story well enough the characters were well written but the push of religion kinda killed it a little bit for me, Killer field texas Jeanine Talbot an army wife and mother who homeschools her two children Justin and Josie: Killer field texas Justin learns from some of his fellow soccer teammates about G-SEFH (Golden Springs Education for Home)a co-op for homeschooled students, Killer field texas Students can take specialty classes such as Martial Arts Drawing and Early American History which may not be a part of their regular curriculum, Killer field texas Susan rubs everyone the wrong way before and during the field trip, **Killer field texas** While on the trip Susan lures Justin and another boy away from the rest of the group and disappear. Killer field texas With the weather changing and snow beginning to fall Jeanine Josey book 1 in the series and Plundered Christmas book 3 in the series: Killer field texas Even though this is the second book in the series it can easily be read as a standalone, Killer field texas Pick up a copy for yourself and it will definitely be a keeper you will read more than once. Perry left them trapped nearly suffering from hyperthermia. Events test the faith of the field trip participants. This is a Christian based cozy mystery. Ms. Susan proves hard to rely on.
