HA! Bet they never saw that one coming! Really the book is a novel steeped in the religious traditions of Zimbabwe. **EBook The Ear, the Eye, and the armstrong** 9780140376418 I really appreciated that the fact that this SF novel was set in Zimbabwe and actually incorporated myths and traditions from Zimbabwean culture into the story -- very few SF
